MEREDITH

Meredith can be spelled or misspelled in many ways. Following are some, but certainly not all of the alternative spellings approximately in the order of the frequency of their occurrence: Merideth, Meridith, Meredeth, Meredah, Meridah, Mereday, Meriday, Meriday, Meridy, Merrideth, Merridith, Marridith, Merrydyth and Merrydeath.

The relationships between the various Merediths in 18th and early 19th century America is far from clear. Many of these early families lived in Virginia and sorting them out is a work in progress. The one thing that appears certain is that the Daniel Meredith from whom this Meredith family descends was born in Virginia in 1792.¹

Daniel Meredith was the son of William and Nancy (Skaggs) Meredith of Russell County, Virginia.² William had signed a petition in 1795 for separating a new county (Tazwell) from Russell, but by the time the new county was formally established the Merediths no longer lived there.³

William and Nancy (Skaggs) Meredith went to Green County, Kentucky in 1796 to join Joseph and Nancy (Skaggs) Meredith who had preceded them there a few years earlier. William's wife was the aunt of Joseph's wife. It is thought, though not proved, that Joseph and William Meredith were brothers. William Meredith had disappeared from Green County, Kentucky, records by 1801.

In 1836 Daniel Meredith was referred to in the Green County, Kentucky, estate papers of one Moses Skaggs, brother of Daniel's mother Nancy (Skaggs) Meredith. Daniel with his brothers John, James, Matthew/Matthias and William were heirs of the deceased Moses Skaggs. This came about because at the time of the settlement of the estate of the childless Moses Skaggs in 1836, both William and Nancy (Skaggs) Meredith were deceased. The estate papers note no place of residence for the five Meredith brothers only that they had removed from that jurisdiction.

There was no mention of the Meredith's daughter Zelpha in the Green County Skaggs estate case and she may have been deceased. David Meredith and Moses Meredith are two other probable children of William and Nancy Skaggs Meredith. These two are found in close proximity to the known Meredith brothers and followed much the same migratory patterns. No record beyond his mention in the estate case was found for Matthias Meredith so he may have died before or shortly after reaching maturity.

A William Meredith appears in the White County, Tennessee, Court Minutes of May 15, 1810. "William Meredith to review and mark and lay off a road." Meredith daughter Zelpha and her husband James Laxton, Jr. had relocated there from Green County, Kentucky, 11 is not known if this reference is to William Meredith, Sr. or to his son William. Meredith, Jr.

Whether Daniel Meredith went directly from Green County, Kentucky, to Hickman County, Tennessee, is uncertain. He is presumed to be the Daniel Meredith who served various enlistments from Hickman County from June 1814 through January 1815 in the War of 1812-1814 in Pipkin's 1st Regiment of West Tennessee Militia. 12

According to family records Daniel married Margaret O'Neal in Logan County, Kentucky, on 5 January 1817.¹³ The O'Neals and Olivers living there at that time were thought to be her families.¹⁴ The location of their marriage is in question in the face of Daniel's 1812 Hickman County, Tennessee, enlistment.

In the 1820's all the Meredith brothers and their sister Zelpha Laxton were living in Hickman or Perry Counties, Tennessee.¹⁵ By 1828 Daniel and his presumed brother Moses had moved west in Tennessee to Weakley County.¹⁶ It is likely the John O'Neal living in Weakley County at that time was related to Daniel's wife, Margaret, possibly her brother.¹⁷

A number of factors conspire to make researching the Meredith family difficult. The area of western Tennessee which became Weakley County in 1823 had been Chickasaw Indian territory. Margaret O'Neal, Daniel Meredith's wife, was purported to have had Indian ancestry, whether Chickasaw or not, is unknown. Records for the territorial period are virtually non-existent and for early Weakley County sparse. After Daniel Meredith's move to Pulaski County, Missouri, in 1832¹⁹ the possibility for research in civil records does not improve. The area of Pulaski County in which Daniel resided became Kinderhook (Camden) County in 1841. The courthouse in Camden County burned in 1902 destroying the records and there are no Pulaski County records before 1903.

"Probably the first school house (in what was to become Camden County) was built on the farm of Daniel Meredith in 1833.²⁰ Shortly after July, 1841, Daniel Meredith served on the first grand jury impaneled in Camden County.²¹

As noted previously, and according to a Meredith family Bible, Daniel was married to Margaret O'Neal 5 January 1817.²² No church or civil record of this marriage has been found. After Margaret's death 29 July 1852,²³ Daniel took a second wife by whom he had a daughter.²⁴ Daniel Meredith died 10 December 1865 in Camden County, Missouri,²⁵ and was probably buried on his home place.

Mathias Meredith, born 25 April 1820 in Weakley County, Tennessee, was the second oldest of Daniel and Margaret's ten children.²⁶ On 25 September 1842 in Miller County, Missouri, Mathias married Surrilda/Sarilda Wiseman, daughter of Benjamin Wiseman and Sarah Winfrey.²⁷ Surrilda was born 16 August 1824 and after her death 20 March 1863,²⁸ Mathias married twice more, but had no children from these unions.²⁹ Mathias Meredith served in the 47th Regiment of the Missouri Militia (Union) during the Civil War and died 10 August 1906.³⁰ Both he and Surrilda are buried in Glover Chapel Cemetery in Camden County, Missouri.

Like his parents, Mathias and Surrilda Meredith had a family of ten children.³¹ Samuel Meredith, their fourth child, was born 15 October 1849 in Camden County, Missouri.³² Samuel was married three times. His first wife was Rebecca Barnett with whom he had six children.³³ The name of his second wife is not known.³⁴ His third marriage about 1898 was to the widowed Emma (McCollum) Clubb, daughter of Stephen McCollum and Nancy E. Rice.³⁵ Emma was born 17 October 1873 in Chariton County, Missouri, and died 2 August 1924 at Crestline, Cherokee County, Kansas.³⁶ Samuel, who was a long time section foreman for the Frisco Railroad, died in Coffeyville, Montgomery County, Kansas, 11 September 1940.³⁷ Both are buried in Wirtonia Cemetery at Crestline.

The younger of the two sons of Samuel Meredith's third marriage was Norman Vernon Meredith, born 5 August 1904 in Poplar Bluff, Butler County, Missouri. On 10 August 1922 Norman was married in Galena, Cherokee County, Kansas, to Violet May McCleary. Violet, the daughter of John Howard McCleary and Jennie Jeanetta Allen, was born 12 August 1904 in Galena. Norman and Violet Meredith's marriage produced one child, Samuel Lee Meredith, born 9 September 1923 in Crestline, Cherokee County, Kansas. Their marriage was dissolved by divorce 3 May 1946. Subsequently Norman married Catherine (Ice) Carruthers with whom he had a second family. He died in Plumas County, California, 10 April 1976.
