NOTES

- 1. A death is recorded 8 January 1892 in Benton Township, Hocking County, Ohio, for a John Allen, aged 81, cause of death paralysis. My mother-in-law Violet (McCleary) Meredith, great-granddaughter of John Allen [subject of this family group] many years ago had told me the following. She quoted her grandfather, John C. Allen, as saying that he would never forgive himself for allowing his father to die in the "Poor House." It seemed unlikely that the elder John Allen had been allowed to die in the Poor House [also known as the Infirmary] as he had a number of sons living nearby who were prosperous farmers and several daughters at least one of whom was married to a well-off farmer.
- 2. This assumption is based on name and proximity associations and a common migration pattern. The 5th child in this family is named Isaac, a given name not found among the Allens, and possible in honor of Nancy's .presumed father, Isaac Willard.
- 3. Two children surnamed Hoffman are shown in the 1860 Pickaway County Census (Reference 34 above) living in the John Allen household. As the parents of these children are unknown, this suggests, but certainly does not prove, Sarah, second wife of John Allen, might previously have been married to, and widowed by, someone named Hoffman. There is a Pickaway County marriage record 24 January 1838 for a Joseph Hoffman and a Sarah Hoffman.
- 4. John and Mary (Allen) Eichor are found living in Pickaway County, Ohio, in 1860 (reference 30 above). On 3 August 1863 a John C. Eichor married Lucy Ann Hoffman in Pickaway County (reference 39 above). In later censuses the age of this latter John C. Eichor corresponds exactly with that of the John Eichor who married Mary Jane Allen. It would appear that Mary Jane (Allen) Eichor had died before 1863, but this is not proven.

As indicated by the title the material presented on this generation of the Allen family is speculative. This Allen family group is based largely on proximity, relative ages, a similarity of given names and census extractions. James, John (the line through which our family descends) Richard and Harvey Allen are found living next door to each other or in the same immediate neighborhood in the 1830 U.S. census for Harrison Township, Perry County, Ohio. Judging by their relative ages James would appear to have been the father and the others sons. Living in the household of James were two younger males and two females, probably his wife Lucy and a daughter.

By 1840 Harvey and John are still together in Perry County, but James is missing and presumed deceased and another James [James, Jr.] has joined the group. He is of the correct age to have been one of the young males living in the household of the older James in 1830. Now living with James, Jr. is an older woman [60-70] presumably his widowed mother Lucinda "Lucy" Allen. Richard is also missing. Other possibilities for children of James, Sr. and Lucinda Allen are Thomas W. Allen and William Allen of Perry County, Ohio, and Levi Allen of Hocking County, Ohio.

In 1818 a Samuel Allen and a Richard Allen received grants for land in Harrison Township, Perry County, Ohio. No Samuel Allen is found in the Perry County 1820 census and the Samuel found in adjoining Muskingum County was born in Pennsylvania and therefore from another Allen family. No Richard Allen was found in the 1820 Ohio census for the area. The Richard Allen on the 1828 Perry County Personal Property Tax List for Harrison Township and the Richard Allen in the 1830 census (20-under 30) for Harrison Township are not the same person. On the 1828 Perry County Tax List (Land and Houses), Richard and Samuel Allen are still shown as landowners of the same property noted in the 1818 land grants although neither was found in the 1820 Perry County census.

John Allen, the brother of the elder James Allen, also emigrated from Virginia and settled in Perry County. He too had sons James and John. The elder John Allen and his sons settled in Bearfield Township of Perry County and this is of some help in keeping the families straight. John Allen's will was probated in November 1833, but it was very crudely drawn and from his large family, named only wife Margaret and a minor son, Jasper. No will was found for John's brother, the older James Allen.

The Allen brothers, John and James, did not immigrate to Ohio as early as some of these records were generated. John disposed of his Culpeper County, Virginia, property in February 1822, and John of his in 1824 or 1825.

An intensive study of the deed records of Perry and the surrounding Ohio counties might establish more complete and reliable profiles of the families of James and John Allen and the other Allen families in the area.
