

A son named "Johann Jacob" was born to "Martin Weiprecht" of Schönbrunn , and his wife "Margaretha" on July 17, 1722. He was baptized the same day, the sponsor being Johann Munzinger, farmer from Brunnersberg.

A daughter named "Anna Maria" was born to "Martin Weiprecht" farmer and Schellish subject of Schönbrunn, and his wife "Margaretha," on May 7, 1725. She was baptized the same day, the sponsor being Margaretha, wife of Johann Munzinger, farmer from Brunnersberg.

A son named "Johann Georg" was born to "Martin Weiprecht" farmer and Schellish subject of Schönbrunn, and his wife "Margaretha," on April 7, 1727. The sponsor at his baptism was Johann Georg Munzinger, farmer from Brunnersberg. "Johann Georg" died on September 20, 1727.

A son named "Johann Michael" was born to "Martin Weiprecht" farmer and Schellish subject of Schönbrunn, and his wife "Margaretha," on July 27, 1728. He was baptized the same day, the sponsor being Johann Georg Munzinger, farmer from Brunnersberg.

A son named "Andreas" was born to "Martin Weibrecht," farmer and Schellish subject of Schönbrunn, and his wife "Margaretha," on October 20, 1730. He was baptized the same day, the sponsor being Johann Georg Munzinger, farmer from Brunnersberg. "Andreas" died on July 27, 1731.

It might have proved interesting if the research could have revealed the Munzingers connection with the Weibrecht family. *Ε. Μ.*

The following extract is from page "iv" of the introduction to Jesse P. Weybright's **Genealogy of Martin Weybrecht** (Bavaria 1689-Lancaster County, Pa. 1732) – **Weybright – Waybright also Martin Weybright**, (Highland County, Virginia 1800). N.p., ca. 1933.

"The first Weybrecht to come to America was Martin Weybrecht. In the original ship list he signed his name "Martin Weybrecht." His wife's name was Margaret. Their translated passport reads, Worthy Governor and Judge in the high District Brandenburg Onotzbachisherr State Fenchentwang (or Fenchtwangen), testify herewith, that all here and surrounding country (to date), Thank the Lord, there is a healthy air and no danger of contagious disease, therefore we testify Martin Weybrecht, his wife and five children, who with their friends, George Hostman and wife, George Obermiller, as English Colonists to date from their birthplace and dwelling in Schonbroun, High aristocratic, old Schallipher Company left here at Easter to march to the Neckar to the ship, at present respective Atteflat and pass under the little State was given in scale so be it Fenchtwang the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April, 1732. Governor and Judge Portland 270 7:30. (The original Passport and a large German family Bible are still preserved and are in the possession of the Kessler family, descendants of Sarah Weybright Putterbaugh, who lived in Troy, Ohio)."

This genealogy contains nothing additional pertaining to our Weibrecht/Weybrecht line which is not found in other parts of this compilation.

Persons, were imported here in the Ship Loyal Judith, of London, Robert Turpin, Master, from Rotterdam, but last from Cowes, as by Clearance thence." From the Minutes of the Provincial Council, printed in *Colonial Records*, Vol. III, p. 456.

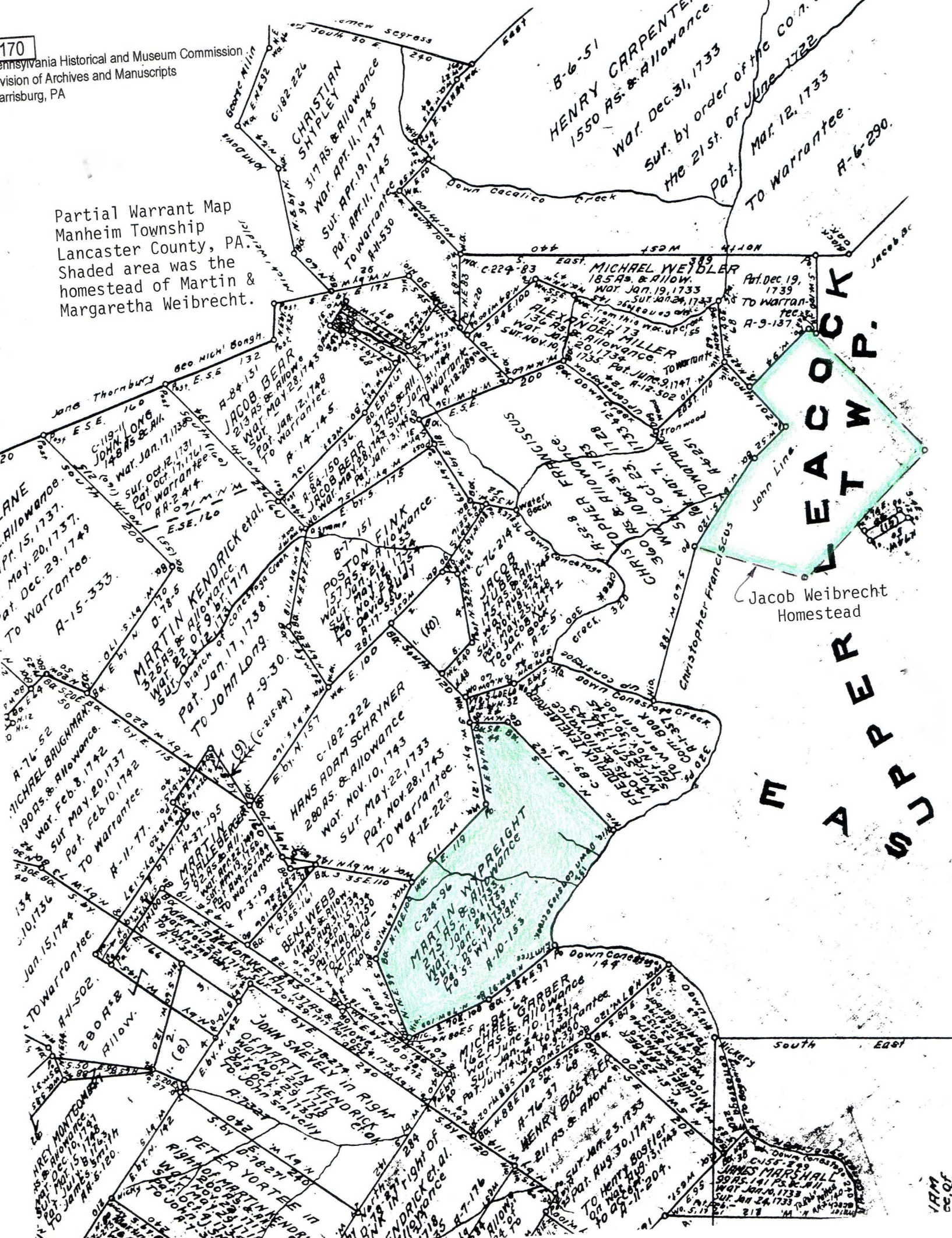
