In the name of God Amen I Michael Weidler of the Township of Manheim in the County of Lancaster & Province of Pennsylvania, Yeoman being in Good Health and Sound Mind & Memory Blessed be God therefore Do hereby make & Publish this my last Will and Testament in Manner and form following that is to say Imprimis I Commend my soul into the Hands of Almighty God who gave it me and my Body to the Earth from whence it came in Hopes of a Joyfull Resurrection through the Merits of my Savior Jesus Christ and as for the Worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased God to Bless me I give & dispose thereof as follows in the first place I do order that all my just Debts & funeral Expenses be paid & satisfied. ITEM I give & bequeath to my loving Wife Elizabeth all the Rents and Profits during her Natural life of a Certain House and lot of Ground situat in the Borrough of Lancaster Bounded on Duke Street by the East and South on a fourteen foot Ally and to the West and North to lots late Isaac Sheaver deceased and I Also give to my said Wife the House and Garden where I now dwels for her during her Natural Life. ITEM I give devise and bequeath unto my Son Jacob Weidler all that Messuage Plantation and tract of Land whereon I Now Dwels Situat in the Township of Manheim in the County of Lancaster adjoining the Lands of Emanuel Carpenter, Rudy Stoner, John Garber[,] Martin Myer[,] John Blair and Conestoge Creek Containing about one Hundred Acres be the same more or less and I Hereby also Give devise to my said Son Jacob One other Tract of land Situat in Leacock Township Adjoining to the land of George Hess his brother Michael & David Crafford containing about Twenty-five Acres be the same more or less these two tracts of Land are to be held by my said Son Jacob Weidler his Heirs & Assigns forever the priveledg of the House and Garden Given to my said Wife during her Life only Excepted and I do Hereby allow Order & direct that my said Son Jacob Weidler Shall Pay Yearly and Every Year Imediatly after my decease on the first day of December to Elizabeth my said Wife ten Bushels of wheat three Bushels of Rie fifty Pounds of Pork and Keep one Cow in Paster for her Use and give & Allow her one Waggon Load of Hay and find and Allow her sufficient fire wood and Hall the same to her dwelling House for her Use the Pastering of the Cow Hay and fire wood is to be given and Allowed Every other Year and the other Articles Yearly during her Natural life and I do hereby farther Order and direct that my said Son Jacob Weidler in Consideration of the lands hereby given to him pay the Sum of Sixty-two Pounds ten Shillings lawful Money of Pennsylvania to my Executors hereafter Named in two years after My decease.
