

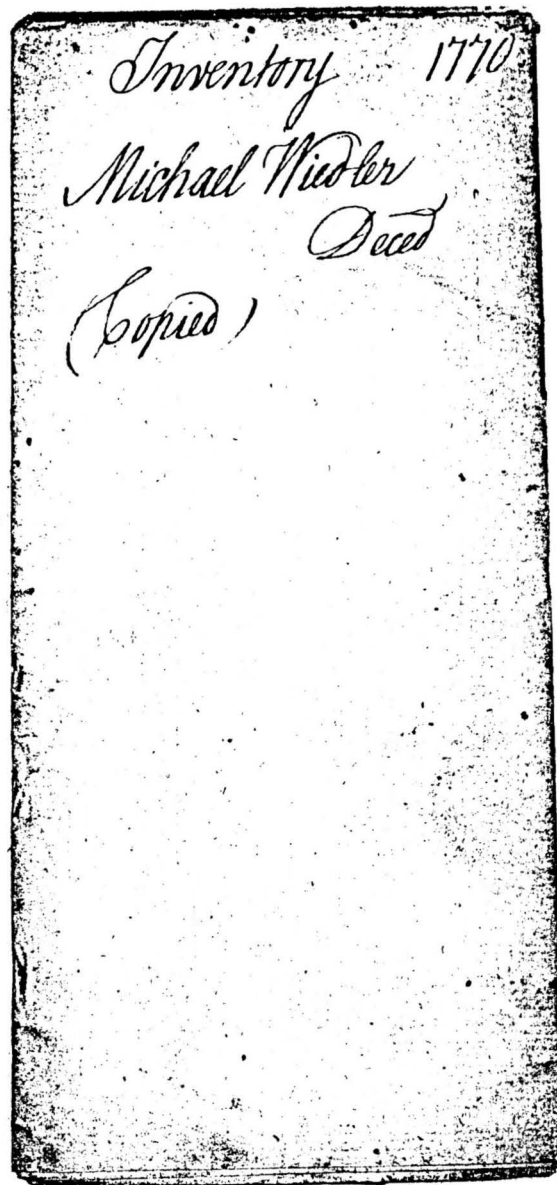

ITEM the Remainder and Residue of my Estat after Debts and legacies ar[e] paid I Give devise and bequeath to my Wife Elizabeth to dispose thereof as she Shall think proper and I do Hereby Nominat Make Constitut and Ordain my said Wife Executrix and my Son John Weidler Executor of this my Last Will and Testament and I doe hereby further Order and Direct and Impower my said Son John or his Executors or Administrators after the Death of my said Wife to Sel[l] that House and lot in the Borrough of Lancaster herein before given to my Wife during her life for the best price that Can be Gott for the same & give & Execut a Good and Sufficient Deed to the Purchaser as Good and Effectual as I my Self could have done to all Intents and Purposes and the Money arising from the sale of the said House and lot I do Hereby Order to be Equally Devided between all my Children Viz John[,] Michael[,] Jacob and my five Daughters aforesaid but the Share of my Daughter Elizabeth I Order to be put out to Interest and the Interest to be paid to her during her life for her Use and Soport and after her decease to be paid to the Heirs of Her Body and for want of Such Heirs then to be Equally devided Between all my Children or their Representatives and I do hereby Revoke and Make Null and Void all former & other Will or Wills by me at any time heretofore made declaring this and no other to be and Contain my last Will and Testament In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal the Fourteenth day of June in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty-nine.

In the name of God Amen I Elizabeth Weidner of the town
 Ship of manheim in the County of Lancaster and province of
 Pennsylvania widow being in health and of sound mind and
 memory God be thanked therefore I do make and publish
 this my last will and testament in manner and form
 following that is to say I commend my soul
 in to the hands of almighty God who gave it me and my
 body to the Earth from whence it came in hopes of a
 joyfull Resurrection through the merits of my savior
 Jesus Christ and as for that worldly Estate where with it
 has pleased God to bless me I dispose thereof as follows in
 the first place I do order that all my just debts and
 funeral Charges be paid and satisfied

Item the Remainder and Residue of all my Estate Real and
 personal whatsoever I shall die possessed of I do hereby order
 and direct to be divided in to seven Equal shares to and
 amongst all my seven children Equally between them —
 Excepting my Daughter Elizabeth to be paid and
 paid to them or their legal Representatives in case any
 of them should be dead as soon as may be after my demise
 and I do hereby also order and direct that one seventh part
 of all my Estate shall be put out to interest by my —
 Executor hereafter named to and for the use and benefit
 of the Children of my said Daughter Elizabeth which
 are now born or hereafter may or shall be born of the
 Body of my said Daughter Elizabeth to be paid to them
 or the survivors or survivor of them in Equal shares
 together with the interest thereon accrued but if my said
 Daughter Elizabeth should survive her present husband
 John Lear I then order and direct that the seventh share
 aforesaid shall be paid to my said Daughter Elizabeth

with the interest if any arrived thereon but if the said John
 bear should survive his said wife and the children of my
 said daughter Elizabeth should also all die intestate under
 age unmarried and without issue and before they or either
 of them have Received that seventh share then and in
 such case I do hereby order and direct that the seventh
 share as aforesaid shall be equally divided amongst
 all my other children or their Representatives in case
 any of them should be dead as aforesaid
 and lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my trusty
 friend and son in law Stephan martin my Executor
 of this my last will and testament allowing this
 and no other to be my last will and testament
 in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
 and seal the thirty first day of August in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and seventy
 three
